#### Financial Aid and Fee Payment Information for Students – Fall 2025

If you have not already done so and will need financial aid, please complete your FAFSA form at <a href="https://www.fafsa.ed.gov">www.fafsa.ed.gov</a>

If your FAFSA is on file, you can track the progress of your application in Self-Service Carolina. Login information should have been provided in your official acceptance letter.

## **Loan Awards and Acceptance**

- If you have a completed FAFSA on file, initial Unsubsidized Loan awards should be visible in your account within the next two weeks.
- Once your award is available, you have the option to accept the full amount, accept a portion, or cancel the loan.
- If you are taking all or part of the Unsubsidized Loan, you must complete **entrance counseling** and sign a **Master Promissory Note** at Both documents must be on file before your aid can be disbursed in August and can be completed at this website: <a href="https://studentaid.gov/">https://studentaid.gov/</a>

## **Additional Loan Funding**

- Your initial award will include up to \$42,500 from the Unsubsidized Loan.
- If you require additional funding beyond this amount, it will come from the **Grad PLUS Loan**, which follows a similar process at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/">https://studentaid.gov/</a>
- The Grad PLUS Loan application opens in May, and we will send out information once it becomes available.

# Financial Aid and Fee Payment Details

- When contacting me with questions about financial aid or fee payment, please include your **VIP ID or USC ID**. I must have this information to review your file.
- Your tuition bill will be available in **Self-Service Carolina in mid-July**.
- Exact tuition rates for the next academic year will be posted in **May or June**, based on when the state budget is finalized.

- If you are using financial aid to cover all fees, assuming your aid is processed and accepted, it will automatically be applied to your bill in **early August**, with refunds issued around the same time. Exact dates will be provided later in the summer.
- If you have a **scholarship**, it should be reflected in your financial aid package by **late June**. Please plan accordingly.
- If you expect a **financial aid refund**, you can sign up for **direct deposit** under the **Account Information** tab in **Self-Service Carolina**.
  - Direct deposit is the preferred method for receiving refunds.
  - o If you do not sign up for direct deposit, you will receive a check by mail, which could take up to **two weeks** to arrive.

## **Health Insurance Requirement**
